## How to get there - Useful Information

First, you have to decide if you're going by car or by bus (Angra dos Reis's airport is small and offers no regular flights). Remember that cars (or any other motor vehicles) are not allowed on the island, so you'll have to leave your car in a paid parking lot.

There are two points of embarkation for the island: Angra dos Reis (bigger and with better infra-structure) and Mangaratiba. Both offer a ferry boat to Abraão, the island's main village. Be careful with the schedule – there is only one round trip per Day, and during holidays lines can be long.

Usually the guest houses located on other beaches have a boat service to take you there. If you're not staying in Abraão or in a guest house, you have two options: go to Abraão and then walk with all your stuff to your destination beach, or hire a private boat. If you choose the second option, don't forget to check the safety equipment and be prepared to spend more. If you're heading to the beaches of Palmas or Lopes Mendes, Mangaratiba is the shortest way; for all other beaches, Angra is the best choice. In this area, the sea is rather calm and the crossing from Angra (21 Km) or Mangaratiba (23 Km) takes around 1 hour and a half.





Ferry Boat Schedule: Angra/Abraão – 3:30 p.m. Abraão/Angra – 10 a.m. Mangaratiba/Abraão – 8 a.m. Abraão/Mangaratiba – 5:15 p.m.

Extra boat: Angra/Abraão – Friday – 10 p.m.

Tickets: Mon – Fri – R\$2,15 Sat/Sun/Holidays – R\$6

## Parking Lots:

Angra dos Reis and Mangaratiba have many options. Most of the companies pick your car up at the dock and bring it back to you at an agreed-upon time. If you prefer you can park it yourself and take the key with you. The price is around R\$6 (uncovered) and R\$8 (covered).

#### **Buses**:

Angra dos Reis´s bus terminal is located at the city entrance. To get to the harbor, take a circular bus that departs every five minutes. In Mangaratiba, the bus terminal is in front of the harbor.

#### From SP:

There are no buses to Mangaratiba. The Reunidas bus to Angra dos Reis departs from Tietê, the trip takes seven hours. Tickets cost R\$20,97. There are intermunicipal buses from Angra to Mangaratiba.

#### From RJ:

Costa verde has trips to Angra (R\$13,18) and Mangaratiba (R\$9,42). The trip takes around two hours.
